

New OMHA Regulation 3.5 iii) – Player Movement

A player from an OMHA AA base category Centre with A programming may tryout for

a) AAA Zone as per the current regulations

b) Home Centre

Caledon is a AA base category Center and we enter teams at the A level, therefore players from Caledon are not eligible for movement under the new OMHA Player Movement clause.

Caledon is open to Non Resident Players (NRP), the maximum number of "Non Resident Players" (NRP) allowed is three (3) per eligible team.

Player movement is only permitted for Minor Peewee and above.

As per the OMHA Regulation only players from bordering OMHA 'A' base category Centres and below (currently NobleKing and Erin Hillsburgh) may try out in Caledon and only for our AA teams.

Upon pre-registration with their Home Centre for the upcoming season the player must request a Non Resident Player (NRP) Passport from their Home Centre to be eligible for the process/tryout.

Players eligibility to try out in Caledon is up to the players Home Centre to determine. The Home Centre must verify that the player is eligible by age and residence for their Home Centre and authorizes the NRP Passport.

Non Resident Players attending the Caledon try outs must present their NRP Passport at the try out sign in.

Below are some Questions and Answers regarding the recent Player Movement Motion that was passed by the OMHA.

Q: Can players from Caledon try out for AA teams in adjacent centers such as Brampton, Georgetown and Orangeville?

A: No, Caledon is an AA base category Centre. This means that players residing in Caledon have the ability to try out for a AA category team.

Q: If my child attends the AA try out in Caledon and is released can we go to another Centre and try out for their AA team?

A: No, the movement is only permitted to a higher level for players from A and below base category Centres. There is no lateral movement A to A or AA to AA.

Q: If my child is released from the Caledon AA team can I try out for A level in another centre?

A: No, the movement is only permitted to a higher level for players from A and below base category Centres. There is no lateral movement A to A or AA to AA.

Q: My child is Atom age player and we live in NobleKing can we try out for the Caledon Atom AA team?

A: No, movement to AA is permitted for participants Minor Peewee and above.

* Should the above differ in any way from the OMHA Manual of Operations, the OMHA Manual of Operations will be considered correct. The above is an attempt to simplify the key points of player movement. The player is responsible for ensuring that they understand the full rules of player movement.
